### **Woburn Recreation Department Pool Safety Rules**

## All pool rules are posted at each location and must be followed. Woburn Recreation Department Staff reserves the right to ask anyone to leave for failing to follow policies.

### Some important rules that we want to emphasize are:

- Swimmers under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Those under 8 must have an adult present inside the pool gated area. Parents are responsible for watching their children and making sure they follow the rules the lifeguards are there to monitor the safety of the pool.
- Smoking or use of drugs or alcohol is not permitted on the property.
- Children who are not toilet-trained will be allowed in the pool if they wear a swimsuit diaper and a swimsuit. Cloth or disposable diapers are not accepted.
- Persons with open cuts, sores, bandages, colds, coughs or communicable diseases are not permitted in the pool.
- All patrons must take a shower prior to swimming in the pool.
